

## MHA Home Team NCO and Specialist (SPF / CNB / SCDF / SPS) Home Team to Civilian Security Career Map

**This map is a guide, not a prescription.** It is intended to help transitioning Home Team regulars understand how their service experience and professional development may relate to civilian security career pathways. Individual progression in both service and civilian careers depends on performance, potential, qualifications, and organisational opportunity. The years shown are an orientating reference only — rank progression is driven by performance and potential, not tenure. The map does not guarantee any specific outcome or career trajectory.

**Entry points:** SPF NCOs enter as CPL (non-degree) or SGT (A-Level / diploma). CNB officers enter at the investigation officer level (illustrative). SCDF NCOs enter as direct-entry SGT. SPS NCOs enter as Correctional Officer (illustrative). All officers complete foundation training at the **Home Team Academy (HTA)**. SCDF additionally trains at the **Civil Defence Academy (CDA)** — Section Commander Course (SCC) and Rota Commander Course (RCC). PME courses and key assignments shown are illustrative — individuals should map their own training against the examples shown. Actual postings vary by agency, vocation, performance, and organisational requirements.

<b>Self-development:</b> Diploma holders encouraged to upgrade to Degree via part-time study or sponsorship. HTA continuing education throughout. Agency-specific: SPF — investigations, crime analysis, protective security, K9. CNB — narcotics law, surveillance, intelligence analysis, compliance. SCDF — Fire Safety Manager cert; HAZMAT; USAR; EMS; civil defence planning. SPS — offender management, rehabilitation programming, case management, secure facility operations. Actual postings and deployments vary by agency, vocation, performance, and organisational requirements.						<b>Singapore Security PWM / WSQ:</b> Applies at Security Officer through Security Supervisor tiers. WSQ Security certifications are mandatory at these levels. At Security Manager and above, PWM no longer applies.  <b>ASIS Certifications:</b> APP — no academic prerequisite; accessible to all. CPP — experience pathway available without a degree; primary credential at Security Manager and above. PCI — Professional Certified Investigator; particularly relevant for SPF and CNB officers transitioning into corporate investigations, compliance, fraud, or due diligence roles. PSP — Physical Security Professional; relevant for SCDF officers moving into infrastructure and physical security roles.  <b>Note on civilian entry level:</b> A transitional step-down in title or grade is common and does not reflect on service record — commercial employers assess commercial experience separately from operational seniority. CNB officers bring highly valued investigation and intelligence competencies for corporate fraud, compliance, and due diligence roles. SPS officers bring people management, case management, and secure facility operations skills valued in healthcare security, facilities management, and social services.
